

The skill and ability to build relationships is not something only a few people are born with. Relationship building is a skill that can be taught and learned. In the first year of the Lighthouse Educator Academy that skill is the focal point. It is our belief that relationship building is a skill that is universal for teachers meaning they can take it to any school, grade level, or content area.

The value we hope to add to new teachers through our mentoring program is the development of their relationship building skills with the hope that it will serve them for the rest of their careers and impact every student they come in contact with. Relationship building skills start with an awareness of the relationship we have with ourselves and expands to our relationships with students, colleagues, administrators, and communities.

Through our monthly meetings and classroom observations we will provide teachers with training, experiences, and feedback on their relationships.
